Not surprisingly, one of the organisation's first ports of call was government leaders in Nigeria's capital Abuja. Fast-growing Nigeria is the jewel in Africa's auto crown with just 44 vehicles per 1,000 inhabitants, far below the global average of 180 vehicles per 1,000 inhabitants, according to recent estimates by Deloitte Africa's 2016 Automotive Insights.

Deloitte Africa Automotive Insights, a study completed in 2018, reported that effective tax rates were 329% and 289%, respectively, on a Toyota Vitz 2003 and Toyota Land Cruiser 2010. This confirmed what Ethiopians already know by heart, that various taxes associated with vehicle imports would quickly build up to reach over three times the purchase price at the country of origin.

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
