Type 3 AHIMTs are deployed as a team of 10-20 trained personnel, representing multiple disciplines who manage major and/or complex incidents requiring a significant number of local, state or tribal resources. They manage incidents that extend into multiple operational periods and require a written Incident Action Plan.

An overview of Incident Management Teams

The certification program is conducted in accordance with FEMA's NIMS Team Typing for Hazardous Materials Response Teams, the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) standards, and EPA/OSHA regulations. The PEMA D2019-02, its attachments, and its appendices cover the requirements and standards of the PEMA HMRT Certification program.
