Next, list the journal or periodical and volume number in italics, followed by the issue number in parentheses.

Include the author and year for a standard parenthetical citation. At the end of any sentence in which you mention or paraphrase the source, add a parenthetical citation with the author's last name, followed by a comma, then the year the article was published. Your parenthetical citation goes inside the sentence's closing punctuation.

Online News Article Note: The format for this type of source depends on whether your source comes from a site with an associated newspaper. If the source does come from a site with an associated newspaper, leave the title of the article unformatted, but italicize the title of the newspaper. Lastname, F. M. (Year, Month Date).

Reference List: Electronic Sources // Purdue Writing Lab

Cite articles in online scholarly journals that also appear in print as you would a scholarly journal in print, including the page range of the article. Provide the URL and the date of access.

MLA Works Cited: Electronic Sources // Purdue Writing Lab

Include an in-text citation when you refer to, summarize, paraphrase, or quote from another source. For every in-text citation in your paper, there must be a corresponding entry in your reference list. APA in-text citation style uses the author's last name and the year of publication, for example: (Field, 2005).

In-text Citation - APA Quick Citation Guide - Library ...

Cite by listing the article's author, putting the title of the article in quotations marks, and italicizing the periodical title. Follow with the date of publication. Remember to abbreviate the month. The basic format is as follows:

MLA Works Cited Page: Periodicals // Purdue Writing Lab

In most cases, the in-text citation is at the end of the sentence in parentheses. If you use the author's name in the text, you don't have to repeat it in the parenthesis at the end. Do not separate the author's name and the page number with a comma. See below for examples.

How to cite a journal in MLA | in-text & full citation ...

Give the secondary source in the reference list; in text, name the original work and give a citation for the secondary source. For example, if Allport's work is cited in Nicholson and you did not read Allport's work, list the Nicholson reference in the reference list. In the text, use the following citation:

The aim of an in-text citation is to point the reader to the full entry on your works cited page. When they see the in-text citation (Smith 24), they'll know to look for the full entry listed on your works cited page under the last name Smith. 2 Write the author's name and page number for printed articles.
