The brief gives us the guidelines by which to mark the essay. With these expectations in mind, critical reading of your essay begins.

We use levels of response mark schemes. Start by determining a level first, and then a mark. A mark scheme is largely a sequence of grids below a question. The grids work from level 1 at the lower end of the ability range to level 4 at the top end.
