MLA Works Cited Page. A Works Cited page is MLA's version of a bibliography. The page is double spaced with entries listed in alphabetical order by the author's last name. If the source does not have an author, then the title is used. If an entry is long enough to require more than one line of text, the subsequent lines are indented a half inch. Entries include three basic elements: author, title, publication information.

Label the page Works Cited (do not italicize the words Works Cited or put them in quotation marks) and center the words Works Cited at the top of the page. Only the title should be centered. The citation entries themselves should be aligned with the left margin. Double space all citations, but do not skip spaces between entries.

In-Text MLA Citations Basic In-Text Citation Rules ANYTHING that is not considered "common knowledge" must be cited in a paper. In MLA style, referring to the works of others in your text is done by using what is known as parenthetical citation. This method involves placing relevant source information in parentheses after a quote or a paraphrase.

Title of Container, Other contributors, Version, Number, Publisher, Publication date, Location. Capitalize the first word in the citation and any words directly after periods. End the Works Cited entry with a period, regardless of which Core Element comes last in your individual citation.

To cite a YouTube video in MLA, the Works Cited entry contains the name of the video's creator, the video's title (in quotation marks), the word YouTube (in italics), the name of the person or organization who uploaded the video, the upload date, and the URL.
